



FACILITY INFORMATION SHEET:

Welcome to the Veterans Memorial Aquatic Center (VMAC). We are located in the 50th State of Hawaii, on the Island of Oahu, in the Pasty T. Mink Central Oahu Regional Park of the City & County of Honolulu maintained by the Department of Parks and Recreation.

We opened our main entrance to the public on the Veterans Holiday, November 11, 2005. With it dedicated to all the men and women who answers the nation's call to duty, and who selflessly serviced and sacrificed so our youth could live and play in peace by the Honorable Mayor Mufi Hannemann.

This facility was designed to host a variety of aquatic sporting events and to be a training site for the community at large. We are open for public lap swimming for the recreational swimmer. Directions to VMAC:

From Honolulu (Waikiki) to VMAC - is about 18 miles: Get on the H-1 "west" for 14 miles; take the H-2 "north" 1 mile; take exit 2 (Ka Uka Blvd); turn left at first light; stay on Ka Uka Blvd. for 1.25 mile. You will enter the Pasty T. Mink Central Oahu Regional Park when you cross the stop light at Kamehameha Highway.

From West Coast (Ko Olina) - is about 13 miles: Take H-1 east for 10 miles; take H-2 north 1 mile; take exit 2 (Ka Uka Blvd.) stay on Ka Uka Blvd. for 1.25 mile. You will enter the Pasty T. Mink Central Oahu Regional Park when you cross the stop light at Kamehameha Highway.

50 meters by 25 meters Olympic swimming pool with a movable bulkhead

Pool configuration periods: Short course (25 yards/25 meters) late August to mid February

Long course (50 meters) mid February to late August

Dive Well

25 meters by 13 meters

Pool depth 10 – 13 feet

Two (1 meter) spring dive boards

Two (3 meter) spring dive boards
